14-year-old Leona Sills (girl) shot at on Texas Street
in Natchez proper, at about 9:40 P.M. Three shots fired at
her by two white teenage boys accompanied by teenage white
girl driving 1962 white Chrysler with Adams County tags.
The two boys were identified by witnesses to the shooting as
Eugene Butler and Robert Lee ~~Riley~~ Riley.
Leona Sills had not been active in the movement, was not injured.
Greene says that he doesn't think they were trying to hurt any-
one in particular, but to scare Negroes.
It was rumored that someone else in the Negro community had
been shot in Natchez same day. No info known.
