February 28, 1964 Friday NATCHEZ, MISSISSIPPI from George Greene taken by Mary

14-year-old Leona Sills (girl) shot at on Texas Street in Natchez proper, at about 9:40 P.M. Three shots fired at her by two white teenage boys accompanied by teenage white girl driving 1962 white Chrysler with Adams County tags.

The two boys were identified by witnesses to the shooting as Eugene Butler and Robert Lee Riker Riley.

Leona Sills had not been active in the movement, was not injured. Greene says that he doesn't think they were trying to hurt anyone in particular, but to scare Negroes.

It was rumored that someone else in the Negro community had been shot in Natchez same day. No info known.
