Three brothers from the Bouldin family were arrested Friday/ they had been driving on the highway and pulled out and passed the Canton sheriff. He claimed they were trying to run him off the road. They went over to his house later to straighten it out, and he came outside with a gun. They were arrested first on the charge of resisting arrest, disturbing the peace and ~~kkkkkkkkkkkk~~ attacking the sheriff. Only the resisting arrest charge stands now. ~~kkkk~~ The brothers are 16, 17, and 19 years old.

Also, C.O. Chinn, who was arrested last week for carrying a concealed weapon and disturbing the peace is in jail now--his appearance bond is \$1000. Scott Smith was arrested at the same time. He has been tried and convicted of disturbing the peace. His sentence is \$1000 fine, 6 months in jail and \$500 appeal bond.

The bonds for all of the people ~~kkk~~ have been arranged but the sheriff is holding them up.
