This morning an attempt was made to get a habeas corpus for Pete Stoner who has been in jail in Nattiesburg since January. The judge in Jackson said he ~~did not have the power to grant the habeas corpus.~~ He also refused to bring Pete into court to let the jury see the black eye and ~~lash marks~~ lash marks he has gotten while in jail. The city attorney claimed that Pete had merely been a fight with prisoners when transferred to the Hinds county jail for the trial.

Pete therefore has about 45 days more to serve of his two 60 day sentences, he will be transferred back to Nattiesburg.

Today local Greenwood ministers met with SACC, SCLC, and NAACP in Greenwood to plan for a freedom day a week from this Friday. A social action committee was formed and ministers agreed to open more local churches for mass meetings and preach "freedom sermons" on Sundays. They also agreed to try to work with ministers who have not cooperated with the movement until now. The ministers want to be responsible for holding one mass meeting each week.

They would like to have about 8 ministers from the North come into Greenwood as soon as possible to work canvassing, etc. and then be in the city for Freedom Day. Local ministers have agreed to house them if they can come.
