Dear Judy,

I just wanted to let you know some of the things that are happening on the Freedom School. The only problem we have is in houseing, as of today we have homes for about 25 students from out of town. We are working on it, and everything will be okay by the 2nd.

The place where we will have the school is Monumental Baptist Church, just around the corner from the office. The set up is kind of unbelievablly good. We have the use of the large auditorium, which has a stage, for any preformances we want to give, and two large meeting rooms. We have 12 small rooms to be used for workshops. We have kitchen facilities, and a dinning room for 200. The pastor called me today, and said that we could use the yard in back of the church for barbrcues and outdoor parties. He has also promised one Sundays collection to the Freedom School

We have 2,354 books sorted and packed. Those same books can be used in Cordele if they are needed. One woman is giving us A Negro history library, that she has collected over the years. This same woman is giving us 75 records(folk, blues, and Jazz). An artist is doing some large poster board illustrations of famous Negroe's. We have pictures of slave ships and all kinds of great visual aids.


We have a truck load of food, and a fifty dollar check to food with.




