Things and people here are really moving. Every time recruiters come to campuses from Dow, the armed forces, etc. they are given a rough time and very often thrown off. The campuses in general are really alive. (none of us were involved in the Brooklyn College thing -- it just happened) There has been a great upsurge of feeling fof an Oakland-type Stop The Draft Week on the campuses. A coalition has been formed to organize this, in which The Resistance has a great deal of influence. (National Mobilization is doing nothing and will probably colapse, but Student Mobilization has sent out a national call for a Stop The Draft Week Dec. 4th-8th and is working hard on the one in N.Y.) The schedule for our thing im here is as follows: Mon.-return of draft cards in a church; Tue.-traditional sit-in at Whitehall by prominant people, women and people who dig sit-ins; Wed.-Fri.-close down Whitehall by mobile tactics (applying the report you sent me) We could really use help with the mobile tactics -- how would you like to spend a couple of weeks in beautiful New York?

Ed has been working with The Resistance here and the rest of the gang is in Washington D.C. Matt was going to refuse induction on Nov. 15th but they found he had an ingrown toenail and posponed his induction for three months. (many of the Oct. 16th people have received I*A, including me, but very few have received induction orders)
